Eastbound: Leave I-40 at exit 172 north onto Hwy 46. Drive 4 miles then take a right on Hwy 70 (at Rite Aid Drug Store). Drive 4 miles and turn right at the small brown "Park Entrance" sign. Follow signs within the Park to Inn/conference center (through woods 2 miles). Westbound: Leave I-40 at exit 182. Turn left onto Hwy 96, go 12 miles to U.S. Hwy 70. Turn right on Hwy 70, proceed 2.5 miles, turn right into park entrance as above.

Biographical profiles of him have appeared in the New York Times, Newsweek, Time, The New Yorker, and Playboy.
